



Minutes of the CSDA Board of Directors
Thursday, December 6, 2018

CALL TO ORDER - The meeting was called to order by President Jack Sondergard at 8:00 AM on Thursday, December 6, 2018. The Assistant CSDA Executive Director, Erin O'Brien, recorded the minutes.

OPENING REMARKS - Jack Sondergard welcomed everyone to the meeting and asked attendees to introduce themselves.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES - Motion was made and seconded to accept the minutes of the September 6, 2018 Board meeting as written. Motion was passed by unanimous vote.

TREASURER'S REPORT – Mike Orzechowski presented the Treasurer's Report for the period ending November 30, 2018. Motion was made and seconded to accept the report as presented. Motion was passed by unanimous vote.

Orzechowski presented the 2019 budget as recommended by the Finance Committee. Jami Harmon asked that the line item for Market Development Sponsorship be renamed to Sponsorships so the responsibility for that income is not solely on the Marketing Committee. Motion was made and seconded to accept the 2019 budget as presented. Motion was passed by unanimous vote.

BUSINESS OF THE MEETING

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Patrick O'Brien presented the CSDA Executive Director's Report covering current membership status, new members, training, safety, standards and specifications, *Concrete Openings* magazine/website, exhibitions, related associations, annual conventions, public relations activities, promotional materials, CSDA website, social networks and future meetings. The CSDA Executive Director's Report is attached.

CERTIFICATION COMMITTEE

Doug Walker presented the committee report. The committee is continuing to work on developing a template to assist applicants in completing the Quality and Environmental Control sections of the application. Current auditor Glenn Purdue is planning on retiring soon, so the committee is actively searching for a new auditor.

MARKETING COMMITTEE

Jami Harmon presented the committee report. A subcommittee was created to finalize the plan and timeline for the hiring of the Market Development Position (MDP) and the subcommittee's goal is to have a person in this position by the 2019 Convention. The subcommittee includes Matthew Finnigan, Bill Fisher, Jami Harmon, Patrick Harris and Erin O'Brien.

A survey will be sent out to Canadian contractors to determine interest in the Canadian Concrete Expo and determine if CSDA should exhibit or attend in the future.

CONVENTION COMMITTEE

Erin O'Brien presented the committee report for Kevin Baron. Registration is open for the 2019 Convention & Tech Fair in St. Petersburg, Florida, and the convention brochure is being mailed out this week. Attendees are encouraged to arrive early to watch the Firestone St. Petersburg Grand Prix race the weekend of March 8-10, ahead of the Convention dates of March 11-15 and everyone is encouraged to reserve their hotel rooms now. Meeting attendees were reminded of the early-bird registration deadline of January 18, 2019.

The committee conducted a site visit to the San Diego area in October to visit seven properties on the short list for consideration for the 2020 Convention. Contracts will be requested from the top two options, the Park Hyatt Aviara and the Omni La Costa Resort, and the plan is to sign a contract by the end of 2018.

ELECTION COMMITTEE

Donna Harris presented the committee report. The slate for the 2019 Officer and Board nominees has been finalized. The nominee for Vice President is Mike Orzechowski (DITEQ Corporation) and the nominee for Secretary/Treasurer is Kellie Vazquez (Holes Incorporated). The slate of Board nominees is: Ty Conner (Austin Enterprise), Dan Dennison (Diamond Tools Technology), Mark DeSchepper (Echo GPR Services), Bruce Ferrell (Prosoco), Jami Harmon (GSSI) and Greg Lipscomb (Diamond Products).

GPR IMAGING COMMITTEE

Bruno Silla presented the committee report for Mark DeSchepper. The syllabus, course content and manufacturer involvement were reviewed and approved for the GPR Methods & Theory course at WOC 2019. The committee requested a Certificate of Attendance to be provided to the course attendees upon completion of the course.

The committee is reviewing date and location options for holding a GPR Certification course in 2019. The 2019 Convention was mentioned as an option. Additional instructors for the GPR classes were discussed.

MANUFACTURER COMMITTEE

Greg Lipscomb presented the committee report. The committee reviewed equipment responsibilities for each manufacturer for the training classes in 2019.

Hilti has volunteered to host the fall 2019 101 training classes at their facility in Tulsa, OK, pending completion of a new training center. Dates will be finalized in the next couple of weeks.

The WOC 2019 Raffle at the CSDA booth is set with donations coming from Brokk, Diamond Vantage and Vacuworx. The manufacturers will notify CSDA of the items they are donating by December 31.

MEMBERSHIP COMMITTEE

Ty Conner presented the committee report. The committee discussed sending out a request for solicitations for the MDP later in 2019.

Conner announced that vice-chair Dan Dennison would be taking over as the new committee chair effective immediately.

NEXT GENERATION COMMITTEE

Kellie Vazquez presented the committee report. The Next Generation Networking Reception will again be held at the Renaissance Las Vegas on Wednesday, January 24 at 4:30 PM. Invitations will be sent to committee members when the details are finalized, and printed copies will be available at the CSDA booth.

Next Gen is holding two optional activities at the 2019 Convention. A Brew Bus Brewery and Mural Tour will take place Tuesday, March 12 at 3:00 PM while a "Yoga and Mimosas" event will be held on Thursday, March 14 at 7:00 AM. All are invited to attend.

The committee continues to discuss details of an individual operator membership category. They will also hold a social media photo contest, with the winner receiving a free training class.

POLISHING COMMITTEE

Bruce Ferrell presented the committee report for Jessica Ledger-Kalen. The three rounds of surface texture testing are complete, and the data is being analyzed by outside firms, including Taylor Hobson and CIM (Construction Industry Management), at no cost to CSDA. The committee would like to thank all manufacturers and volunteers who participated in this testing,

as total costs were estimated to be about \$100,000. All manufacturers who participated in the testing and requested their own data has received that information.

The committee is reviewing the CSDA polishing specification and will be working on updating a draft to submit to the Standards & Specifications committee for review.

The two polishing classes for WOC 2019 are ready to go. The course content for Concrete Polishing 101 will remain the same with a new instructor, Craig Cowan, who did a test run recently. Cowan will also instruct the new Putting Polished Concrete to the Test course, and course content and materials have been submitted to the Training committee for approval.

SAFETY COMMITTEE

Matthew Finnigan presented the committee report. The committee is updating all CSDA safety materials to reflect a change from MSDS (Material Safety Data Sheets) to SDS (Safety Data Sheets). New TSTs on Electrical Cords, UV Protection, Respirators and Marijuana are being developed.

The “pay to play” program for silica testing data continues to develop. Members can buy in at \$100 each, and as long as they input data, they will get all data that is released. Eight to ten members have confirmed they will be buying in. The committee plans to launch the official program prior to World of Concrete.

STANDARDS & SPECIFICATIONS COMMITTEE

Mike Orzechowski presented the committee report. The committee is developing new Best Practices on Safety Data Sheets (SDS) and securing wall openings.

TRAINING COMMITTEE

Kellie Vazquez presented the committee report for Patrick Harris. The 101 and 201 courses held this fall in St. Pete were reviewed. The committee would like to add group JSAs, PPE review and a general safety review to the beginning of each class to enforce proper safety protocols. Both sets of courses had record attendance, with 51 students for the 101 courses and the 201 Operator Certification series had 43 students.

There were two students who did not pass the 201 Wire Sawing written test. The committee will review the tests and discuss with instructor Rick Norland to determine if those students will be certified or not.

The CSDA staff requested that the committee set forth guidelines on what constitutes a passing grade on the 201 course written tests. Currently, there is no confirmed pass/fail standard.

The storage shed at St. Petersburg College (SPC) has a deteriorating floor that needs repaired or replaced. Patrick Harris is working with SPC on this project. John Robinson has been asked to provide local recommendations to help repair the floor.

The first two sections of the Cutting Edge update script are completed and reviewed. The re-write and update of the online Cutting Edge course is being completed by Digital Lagoon as part of a long-term project to update Cutting Edge and the CSDA Training website.

The committee would like to purchase CSDA Instructor shirts or hard hat bands for the instructors as the training classes with a hands-on element to make the instructors more easily identifiable.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

There was no unfinished business.

NEW BUSINESS

Erin O'Brien stated that the CSDA office has been receiving a lot of questions from members about emails they are receiving that appear to be coming from CSDA, or a CSDA Officer. She made a short presentation educating Board members on the different types of email scams, how to spot a scam and what to do about it. These emails are not coming from CSDA and it is up to members to be vigilant and learn to recognize a scam.

Kellie Vazquez reported one of her operators was in a serious car accident and is in critical condition in the hospital. She has set up a GoFundMe page for his family to assist in covering medical and other expenses. Anyone interested in donating can visit the Holes, Inc. Facebook page.

NEXT MEETING - The next meeting of the CSDA Board of Directors will be held on January 23, 2019 in Las Vegas, Nevada at the Las Vegas Convention Center during the World of Concrete.

ADJOURNMENT - There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 10:02 AM.

Training Update

- Four CSDA training courses are scheduled for the World of Concrete 2019. The two newest courses are Testing Methods and Equipment for Polished Concrete Floors and GPR Methods & Theory. Two repeat courses from prior years include Estimating and Concrete Polishing.
- The Slab Saw/Core Drill, Wall/Hand Sawing and Wire Sawing 101 courses were held at St. Petersburg College in Clearwater, FL on October 15-19. Fifty-one graduated from the three courses. The Slab Saw/Core Drill, Wall/Hand Sawing and Wire Sawing 201 Operator Certification courses were held November 5-9. Forty three graduated from the three courses.
- The first OSHA Silica Training course was held on September 4 in Milwaukee, and seven students were registered with five students attending. A second class will be held on December 6 in St. Augustine, FL and four students are currently registered.
- The CSDA online training website continues to be popular. To date, 1,173 users (+5% since the September 2018 Board meeting) with 228 (+2%) companies have taken 5,399 exams (+21%). CSDA has now received \$63,612 (+2%) for its portion of the registration fees since January 2007.

2. Safety Handbook / Safety Manual

- A total of 6,770 CSDA Safety Handbooks (original + English/Spanish) have been sold since introduction in January 2000.

- CSDA received a Certificate of Recognition for its participation in the OSHA 2018 Safe + Sound Campaign.

Standards & Specifications

- Three new documents were approved at the September meeting and have been released on the CSDA website. Best Practices CSDA-BP-022 *Dust Control* and CSDA-BP-023 *Noise Control* were released, as was a Whitepaper titled “Dry Dust.”

- The number of paid ad pages for the December 2018 issue is up three pages from the last issue, and only slightly down from the December 2017 issue. This slight decrease is attributed to tightening of ad budgets and the continued consolidation of manufacturers.
- The percentage of ad pages to total pages is targeted at a maximum of 35 percent. The ad-to-page percentage for the December issue was at 29 percent, leaving room for additional advertisers.

2. Concrete Openings Highlights

- The December issue of *Concrete Openings* contains four CSDA contractor job stories:
 - Massive core holes drilled at a dam in Houston, Texas.
 - Restoration of the structure of a 151-year old church in Columbus, Ohio.
 - Demolition of a major bridge linking New York and New Jersey.
 - Wire sawing and core drilling at a busy waterway lock in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania.
- Additional sections include safety, certification and health-related articles, industry news and a CSDA training testimonial from Jason Young of Donley Concrete Cutting in Columbus, Ohio.
- The December issue also features the second Specifiers Corner article written by George Seegebrecht.
- Free *Concrete Openings* subscription forms continue to be received through the *Concrete Openings* website. A total of 481 new print subscriptions (up +6% since September) have been received through the current website since it went live in March 2015, bringing the total to 3,132.

3. Concrete Openings Website

- The *Concrete Openings* website features current and archived issues up to the September 2018 issue.
- The new website has over 106,200 page views (+6% from September) since its launch in March 2015. This brings the total page views for **concreteopenings.com** to 205,335. The site has over 45,000 unique page views with 62% of those visitors being from the U.S. and Canada.

Exhibitions

- An aggressive marketing campaign is underway for WOC 2019 to advertise CSDA’s Source Code A26. The goal is to reach not only the concrete cutting industry, but also other industries, in an attempt to maximize exposure and increase the rebate amount. Web-based and social media marketing will be part of this plan, as well as print and mail campaigns.

- The Keynote Speaker will be retired Navy Captain Kent "Eagle" Ewing, who commanded the aircraft carrier USS America in Desert Storm. Captain Ewing will share his leadership strategies for successfully commanding over 4,000 soldiers in wartime, as well as some of his entertaining naval stories.
- Business and technical presentations, panel discussions and roundtables at the convention will cover digital marketing and social media, testing and regulations for marijuana in the workplace, how companies are managing the OSHA Silica Rule and more.
